

Oradea

Oradea, the capital city of Bihor County crossed by the river Crişul Repede, nestles in the western part of Romania, 8km from the Hungarian border. The present day city emerged from the union of several tonwships. According to the 2012 census the population of Oradea is 183.123, of which 26% are Hungarians.

The Hungarian name of the town (Nagyvárad) comes from the word várad=little castle. Its Latin name is (Magno) Varadinum, in Romanian it is Oradea, in German Grosswardein. The city's roots go back to the 11th century when in the current location of Oradea there was an earth fort. Its monastery was established by king (Saint) Ladislaus I.

Throughout the centuries the ethnic composition of the city has become quite varied, which has had its impact on what the city is today.

At present our library possesses around 50.000 volumes and provides access to several local and foreign periodicals. Students and trainers of our university have access to a number of foreign database, such as JSTOR, EBSCO. Our library uses the open-shelf system, with an electronic catalogue.
